### Spellings - (anti means 'against')

Your weekly spellings are: antiseptic, anticlockwise, antisocial, antidote, antibiotic, antivenom, anti-ageing, antifreeze, antiperspirant and antigravity.

- 1) Copy one at a time.
- 2) Look at it for 10 seconds.
- 3) Cover it then write it again from memory.
- 4) Write the word again if it's incorrect.

### Maths

Estimate then use a columns to solve these:

$$1873 + 3489 =$$

$$6232 - 3685 =$$

(When you estimate, round each number and use a mental method.)

Now use the inverse to check it. Remember the inverse should contain all 3 numbers from your sums.

#### 1) Which one do you prefer and why?
