As mentioned on Seesaw this week, and popped in your child's book bags, we are focusing on letter formation using the rhymes introduced to the children.

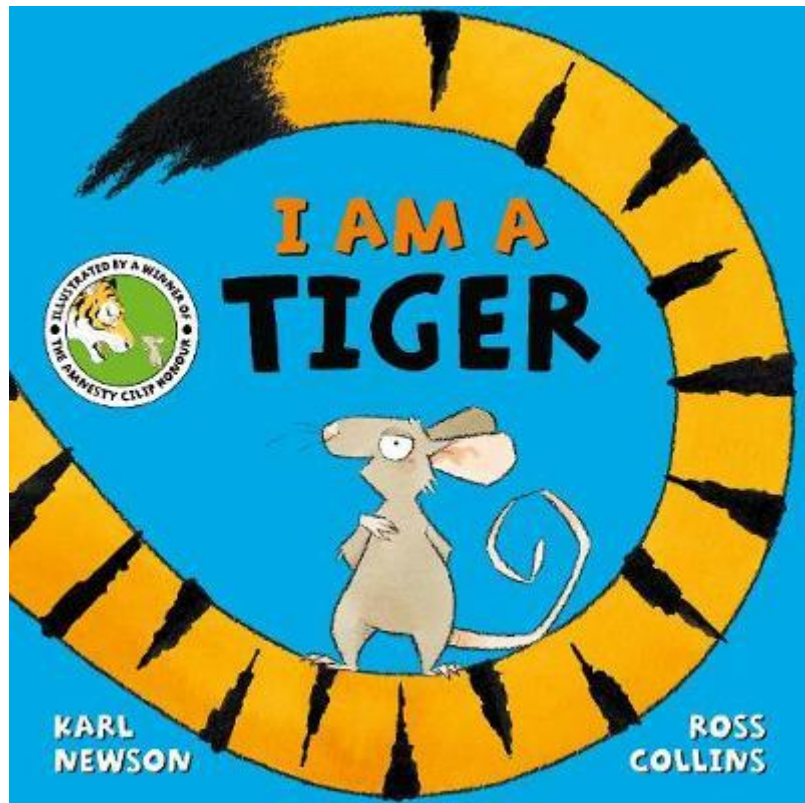
Tricky Words
