New sounds this week: **g, o, c, k** meaning that we have now covered the following sounds: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c and k. We have also looked at the tricky word 'I'. This is a sight word that children need to learn by sight and memory.

We have been looking at the Rainbow Fish story this week. Children have been using wonderful vocabulary and learning the meaning of unfamiliar words such as 'ocean'.
