In Maths, we have used two different websites to help us deliver lessons with a focus on: Fractions, Time, Converting Measures, Pictograms and Graphs, Perimeter and Area. For English, the children have looked at the opening of stories. They have also completed weekly units of work related to chocolate and fantastical beasts, and recited poetry before creating and performing their own. Daily arithmetic and spelling tasks have also been completed.



In Science, we have been studying the properties of solids, liquids and gases, looking at how the particles behave in each. We have also been studying North America, finding the oceans and countries there, and the physical and human features of the continent. For Music, the children have developed their skills in pulse and rhythm. They have learnt different songs with 2, 3 and 4 beats in a bar. In PSHE sessions, the children have been researching what it is like being part of a community. The children have been given weekly PE challenges focussing on rugby, netball, gymnastics, dance, yoga, orienteering and ball skills.
